### NOTICE FOR ASSESSMENT INTERVIEW BOARD (AIB) APPLICANTS

#### Educational Requirements

Following the October 2011 meeting of the Council Institute of Maxillofacial Prosthetists & Technologists (IMPT), it was decided that the qualifications listed below are prerequisite for individuals seeking advancement to Full Membership status of the IMPT.

- 1) **Diploma in Professional Studies (DPS)**, Maxillofacial Prosthetics and Technology, Manchester Metropolitan University. *Please note: individuals with the DPS must apply before first day of January 2015 as this qualification will be superseded on the last day of December 2014.*
- 2) **MSc in Maxillofacial Prosthetic Rehabilitation**, Kings College, London. *Please note: in addition applicants must complete modules in Craniofacial Development, Osteotomy and Trauma at KCL before sitting an AIB. Student/trainee maxillofacial prosthetists must also be mentored by a maxillofacial prosthetist, who holds Full Membership of the IMPT, during their full course programme.*
- 3) **MSc in Maxillofacial & Craniofacial Technology**, Kings College, London.

Advancement to MIMPT status is made by an individual sitting the IMPT Assessment Interview Board to formally present their application and all AIB requirements need to be met.

From 2013 UK based student/trainee maxillofacial prosthetists will be enrolled within the NHS Scientific Training Programme (STP). This Department of Health funded training initiative will have the Modernising Science Careers MSc qualification incorporated as part of the programme. Students will still have to sit it as an additional requirement.
